  - A guided tour through the history of emergency response. Andy will also examine the thorny items of liability and responsibility for incident clean-up, costs, etc, and use of "Instructions In Writing".
- **Responding To Chemical Incidents & Public Health Risk Assessments** (*working title*)  
**Alec Dobney, Environmental Hazards & Emergencies Dept., Public Health England**
- **Chemical Response – An In-Depth Case Study**  
**Bill Atkinson, 24-7 Emergency Advice**
  - Large chlorine gas reaction. Extensive damage to an industrial premise and surrounding environmental damage. Casual factors, practical difficulties of the response, environmental testing (on and off site), issues with loss adjusters. Transport of waste.
- **Know Your Load!**  
**Neil Stothert, RSK Raw**
  - Case study: an unknown load (solvent) with no paperwork that had been imported, transported and then started leaking, due bad loading.
- **ADR PPE – Are You Providing Adequate Protection?**  
**Brian Eames, Hazchem Safety**
  - Choice of suitable PPE for wide-ranging chemicals but without breaking the bank. Extrapolation of Breakthrough Times & permeation rates for unlisted (untested?) chemicals – chemical families. Use of RPE (e.g. half-mask, not full BA). Face-fit testing methodology
- **Emergency Response Case Studies**  
**Nick Bailey, Ambipar Response**
  - Tanker roll-over, a railway incident, packaging issues with nitro-cellulose and bin-packaging of polystyrene beads.
